

The Green

The green is available for play from 11.00am to dusk on everyday except Mondays and Thursdays when green maintenance delays access to the green until 2.00pm. All members are requested to take care when using the green. Restrictions notified by the Green Manager must be observed and when damage takes place due to improper delivery, mats should be used.

Club Matches

All members are expected to play in the games listed in the Fixtures List where men's, ladies' and mixed matches against other clubs are played most weeks. These provide an opportunity for new bowlers wishing to step up from the fun nights and friendly roll-ups to a more competitive but friendly environment.

Those wishing to be considered for selection should print their name on the Application to Play sheet that is posted on the Captain's notice board two weeks before the fixture. The selections are posted on the same board at the start of the week the matches are due to be played.

Over 55s League

Over 55s are able to register for the Pairs Handicap League which is played each Tuesday in morning and afternoon sessions. Registrations for participation for the following season are posted on the Secretary's notice board at the end of each season.

Roll-ups

Monday and Thursday afternoons are normally reserved for friendly roll-ups and members will make-up into teams of triples as and when sufficient players arrive.

Friday night roll-ups commence at 5.00pm and new members are particularly welcome to bowl from 5.00pm and take part in the after-match socialising which usually includes a fish and chip supper.

Intra club matches

Members are invited to play in weekend intra club matches. Played in a variety of formats both friendly and competitive games are arranged. Players are invited to participate through the Application to Play process and, generally, all those wishing to play are accommodated.

Midweek League matches

Bucks League matches for men are played on a Wednesday night and Chiltern and Thames League mixed triples matches are played during the midweek. Those who would like to play in the Bucks League should contact the relevant team coordinators whilst applications are invited for C&TL matches in the normal way.

Club Competitions

Entry forms for Men's and Ladies' competitions are circulated with the Subscription Renewal forms in March and the draws for each event are posted on the internal notice boards. Each member will be allocated a handicap before the competitions commence and they will be displayed on the internal notice boards.

County Competitions

County events are displayed on the notice boards in the Men's and Ladies' changing rooms and contact details for those wishing to enter the County competitions can also be found there. Further information can be obtained from the Club Secretary whose details can be found on the inner cover.

Dress Code

Weekend matches club matches are played in club shirts and white below the waist. Intra club matches at the weekend are in white tops or club shirts and white below the waist. Matches in mid-week are played in club shirts with grey below the waist, except where indicated "white" in

the fixture list when white is required to be worn below the waist. All friendly roll-ups only require white above and grey below the waist.
